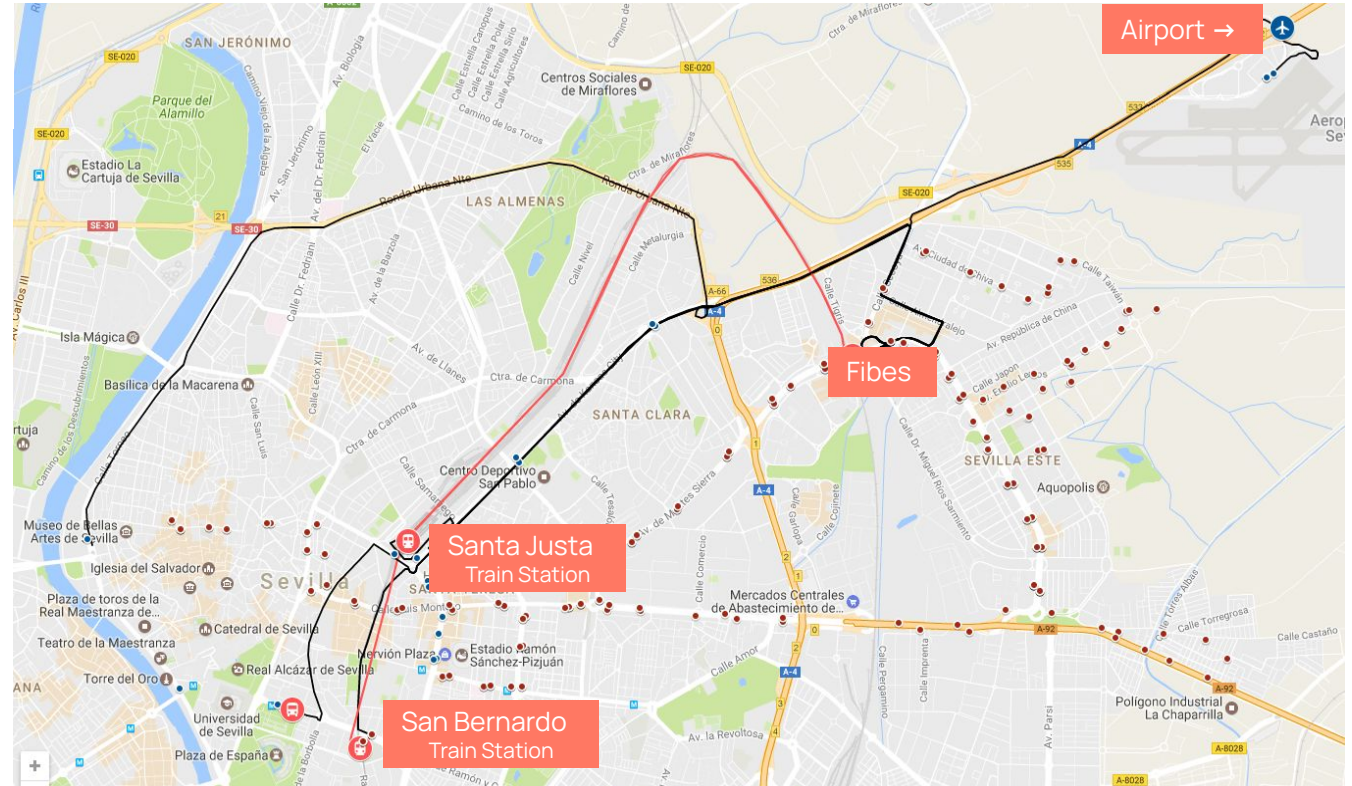

From Airport

FIBES is located in the eastern part of the city, just 5 km from San Pablo airport and the main train station of Santa Justa. It is easily accessible by car via the SE-30 ring road and is also well served by public transport.

San Pablo Airport is only 5 kms from the Congress Centre. It takes **less than 10 minutes by car**.



Access by train

Every 35 minutes, from Santa Justa Train Station, Virgen del Rocío Hospital and San Bernardo Multimodal Station.
It takes less than 15 minutes.



Access by bus

4 lines from the city centre (B4 & 27 & 22 & BTR) to Fibes in less than 30 minutes:

- **Bus fares:** every 10 to 15 minutes.
- **Single ticket:** 1,40 € (an area).
- **Bus card:** price: 1,50€
- **Minimun charge:** 7€
- Single journey **without transfer:** 0,69€
- Single journey with transfer: 0,76€
- **Tourist Card 1 day:** 5€
- **Tourist Card 3 days:** 10€ (All bus lines can be used throughout the day.



Arriving by taxi or VTC

Taxi fares: Taxi fares in Seville are really competitive as the distances are really competitive as the distances are very short.
very short.

An approximate fare from the centre to FIBES should be **between 12 and 15 euros**, depending on traffic.

Vehicles for hire with driver (VTC)

Seville offers a wide range of VTC services. The main companies in the sector operate in the city: **Uber, Cabify y Bolt.**

It is not possible to estimate a service price, as it depends on the demand for services at the time of the request.



Arriving by bike

Seville is an easily manageable medium sized city. Using a bicycle to get around Seville is a great option, **as the city is very flat and we enjoy mild temperatures all year round.** Currently, **there are 200 kms of bike lanes in the city** since Seville signed the Aalborg Commitments on the occasion of the 5th European Conference of Sustainable Cities and Towns held in FIBES in 2007.

Seville is nowadays the best city for cycling in Spain, second in Europe, fourth in the world (according to Reuters) and also according to Copenhagenize.com the prestigious blog specialised in Cycling Urbanism for Modern Cities.



Arriving by bike

In Seville, as in many cities in Europe, there is the possibility of picking up a bicycle and dropping it off at a different point in the city. This service is called [Sevici](#).

The city has **2,500 bicycles available for rent** distributed in **250 Parking Areas**.

- Fares: Short-term pass, **13.33€**; Long-term pass, **33.33€**
- **First 30 minutes**: Short-term season ticket, free of charge; Long-term season ticket, free of charge.
- **First hour** (after the initial 30 free minutes): Long Term Season Ticket: **0,51€**; Short Term Season Ticket: **1,03€**.
- **2nd and every hour thereafter** (after the initial 30 free minutes): Long Term Season Ticket: **1,03€**; Short Term Season Ticket: **2,04€**.

There are many bicycle parking areas around FIBES.



Arriving by bike

Electric bikes

With a rental service with 2,000 units and more than 300 parking points, a project that is part of the municipal strategy to promote sustainable mobility.

The main operator in the city is **Ridemovi**.



Arriving by motorbike

One of the fastest and most agile ways to get around the city is by scooter. Several electric scooter rental companies have been operating for some years, with **Acciona** and **Yego** offering the largest fleets of vehicles.

The use of these scooters is subject to a per-minute rental service, although vouchers are also available.



Arriving by electric scooter

Electric Scooter

Electric scooter rental service with 2,000 units and more than 200 parking spaces on public roads. The main companies operating in the city are **Reby** and **Voi**.

In both companies, the unblocking fee is 1€ and 0,20€ for each minute of use.
